OVERVIEW

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

AECOM was awarded the Program Management contract to oversee the City of Doral's \$150 Million Parks Bond program. AECOM and its subconsultants BCC Engineering, PDS, Dolphin Expediting and CreativeVision Media are responsible for providing the planning, scheduling, management and execution of the design teams and contractors for the program. Additionally AECOM is developing work flows and best practices for program and budget management. AECOM staff are working out of the City of Doral Government Center.

For the month of October, the Doral Central Park team consisting of the A/E firm, CMAR, Program Management Team, and City of Doral are focusing on budget and scope refinement. Progress continues with permitting and variety of site activities including the completion of sheet pile installation around the west side of the lake.

Cultural Arts Center construction is continuing to advance. Multiple major items are progressing at the park. Items of particular note is the completion of the Stormwater Management system and substantial advancement of the roof terrace including service area counter.

The Pedestrian Bridge project continues in the procurement phase. Three firms previously presented their alternative technical concepts (ATC's) to the city and are continuing to refine their proposals. Next step will include the submission of the technical proposals to be reviewed.

The Doral White Course project construction continues with advancements in the dog park, putting green, irrigation system, and rainwater harvesting tank.

Doral Trails and Tails park continues with the conduit layout, bollard installation and procurement of items for installation.

Morgan Levy Park is complete with additional request of grease trap permitting and construction on-going.

DORAL CENTRAL PARK

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Doral Central Park is located at 3000 NW 87th Avenue. The site is situated on 82 acres of which 25 are the lake. It will be the largest park in the City, and one of the largest in the region. The park will include an indoor recreational facility, and aquatics venue with a competition pool, learn to swim pool, splash park and lazy river. Outdoor amenities will include meandering walking paths, tennis courts, basketball courts, baseball/softball diamonds, picnic areas, skate spot and pump track and sensory playscape area.

Additional activities that will take advantage of the lake are a wetland trail, canoe/kayak/paddle boat launch, lake front trails and a lake front promenade. The park will have a formal events lawn to serve as the city's special-events hub with the addition of an open-air amphitheater. All new vehicular traffic pathways, parking and normal and special occasion lighting and landscaping will also surround the park.

PHASE 1 of the park will consist of the Construction Manager taking control of the entire site, fencing it, setting up controlled access entry points and the CM's trailer administration area and trade contractors' area. Specific construction activities during Phase 1 include site demolition. tree relocation, site grading, cut and fill and underground site utility components and rough grading.



PHASE 4 will take the longest of the 3 phases to complete. This part of the site contains all the surface parking lots, and vertical construction components - aquatic venue and indoor recreation building.

Additionally, the hardscape and landscaping is more dense in this area of the site along with more intersecting underground utilities. Planning, coordination and sequencing of work will take more time.



TRAILS AND TAILS PARK

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The park is located at 11645 NW 50th Street, Doral FL. The project includes the installation of additional light fixtures to increase security in the area, replace existing fixtures and or supports and add lighting to the dog and play areas. The existing small and big dog play areas will have their fences checked and any broken areas repaired.


